Scholarship Guidelines

The Morgan Student Aid Fund awards scholarships from funds that have been donated by businesses, civic organizations, and individuals. These scholarships can be awarded based on merit and/or need. Several of the scholarships have specific criteria. Since the same application form is used for all scholarships, the applicant applying for a specific scholarship should write in the upper right-hand corner of the first page the name of the scholarship. All applications are to be turned-in to your assigned school counselor by May 1st. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Specific criteria:

Mary Linn Fox—recipient must have finished fifth grade at Pleasant View Elementary School

Dr. Michael Marsh Memorial Scholarship—priority will be given to a student who graduates from the alternative school program at Berkeley Springs High School

PASS Program Scholarship—recipient must have participated in the PASS Program for a minimum of one year of his/her school career. Scholarship will be sent directly to student's school to support his/her chosen program for post-secondary education.

Ron Clatterbuck Memorial Baseball Scholarship—recipient must have played baseball in high school and be planning to continue to play at the collegiate level

Rotary—at least one scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from each county high school

War Memorial Hospital—

- Applicant should indicate on the application form in Section II the length of the program (2 years or 4 years)
- Applicant must be a senior graduating from a Morgan County school who plans to further his/her education in a healthcare field

W. Ralph Widmyer—preference given to applicant who is pursuing a degree in elementary education

Robert L. Bohrer Memorial Scholarship—Details Pending

General—any additional scholarships available through Morgan Student Aid Fund
