**TRI-STATE FARM TOY COLLECTORS CLUB
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM**

I. Purpose

To provide, annually, financial scholarship assistance to one graduate of the Tri-State Area Schools who enters or has entered into a program of advanced studies leading to a degree in Agriculture/Natural Resources, Agriculture Related Fields - Horticulture, Landscaping, Forestry, or Natural Resource Management related fields, at an accredited institution.

II. Amount

A scholarship worth up to \$1,000.

III. Qualifications

A. Educational Achievement

- 1. Applicant must be a graduate of a Tri-State Area High School.**
- 2. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average at the time of the application.**

IV. Application

The applicant must:

- A. Send a letter of interest to the TSFTCC Scholarship Committee before April 30 of the year of the award.**
- B. Include in the letter a valid transcript (Most Recent).**
- C. Forward two (2) letters of recommendation from persons not related to any member of the TSFTCC. At least one (1) of these letters must be from a recent teacher (last 3 years).**
- D. Be available for interview by the Committee if requested (finalists will be notified).**
- E. Forward a letter from your Guidance Counselor verifying your financial need.**

V. Limitations

- A. The applicant must have been a resident of the Tri-State Area for at least two (2) school years.
- B. The recipient of the scholarship may receive it only one(1) time.
- C. The award will be made based upon the decision of the Committee. The Committee's decision is final.
- D. The Committee will base its decision on the financial need of the recipient and the involvement and achievement in their field of interest thus far.
- E. Should the recipient fail to matriculate for secondary school study, the Committee shall select his/her replacement.

VI. Procedure

A. Announcement

The announcement of the name of the successful applicant will be made before June 1 of each year.

B. Payment

- 1. The Treasurer of the TSFTCC shall forward the scholarship check to the Financial Officer of the institution of higher learning.
- 2. The check shall be sent upon the matriculation of the student.
